

IMPORTANT INSTALLATION NOTES:

1. All work should be done by a qualified electrician.
2. Fixture must be installed in accordance with the National Electric Code and all applicable local codes and ordinances.
3. To reduce the risk of electric shock, insure electricity has been turned off at the circuit breaker or fuse box before beginning.
4. Lamp should never be covered with anything to allow for heat dissipation.
5. Proper grounding is required to ensure safety.
6. All installation and safety instructions should be followed for full warranty coverage.

Instructions for installation




ADJUSTING FIXTURE ANGLE:

1. Unscrew the bolt of the rotating bracket.
2. Adjust to a suitable angle, then tighten the screw.

Brown: Live wire

Blue: Neutral wire

Yellow green: Ground wire



WIRING:

1. Check that voltage is compatible with fixture ballast. Use code compliant connectors for all electrical connections.
2. Turn off all power.
3. Ensure the wall can fully support the weight of the lamp.
4. Connect the brown fixture lead to the black supply lead.
5. Connect the white fixture lead to the white supply lead.
6. Connect the green fixture lead to the green supply lead.

MOUNTING:

1. Uses M10, M12 screws.
2. Turn off the power and make sure the wall can sustain the burden of the weight before installing the lamp.
3. Secure the lamp so that it won't fall.
4. Do not cover the lamp.
5. Turn off all power to the lamp, and make sure the ground line is well secured before turning power on.
